Needs statement: Many clinicians are well-versed in initiating these medications but may struggle with recognizing when and how to taper them appropriately to minimize withdrawal symptoms, prevent relapse, and ensure patient safety. Additionally, there is variability in clinical practice regarding deprescribing guidelines, leading to inconsistent patient care. Addressing this gap through continuing education will help pharmacists apply evidence-based deprescribing strategies, improve patient outcomes. and optimize medication management.

Objectives for Pharmacists: At the end of the presentation, the participants should be able to:

- **Define** deprescribing and explain its role in optimizing medication therapy.
- **Identify** appropriate candidates for deprescribing psychotropic medications based on clinical stability, treatment duration, and risk-benefit assessment.
- **Describe** evidence-based tapering strategies for antidepressants and benzodiazepine receptor agonists to minimize withdrawal symptoms.
- Develop individualized tapering plans incorporating shared-decision making, patient preferences, and nonpharmacological alternatives.
